Mental retardation can also be the result of extreme lack of oxygen near the time of birth. Mental retardation may develop in an older child as the result of serious head injury, stroke, or infections such as meningitis. Developmental tests are often used to assess the child with intellectual disability:

1. Mild Mental Retardation (IQ52-68) Persons within this level of IQ are considered "educable", and their intellectual capacities as adults are found to compare to that of the average 8 to 11 year old child.

### **The Assessment of Social Functioning in Individuals with ...**

Children with mental retardation require a longer period of time to learn a language, develop social skills, and/or care for themselves in terms of dressing, personal needs and eating. It takes a longer time to learn, perform and replicate new skills than a child who develops normally.

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
