Rule of thumb: divide the pixel size (dimension) of the image by the resolution (at least 300 ppi) to get the maximum print size in inches. So, if your image is 2,000 pixels in length at 300 ppi, then you can print it up to six inches or so (2,000 divided by 300).

Some common 1:1 ratios are an 8 x 8 inch photo, a 1080 x 1080 pixel image, or typically any profile picture template on social media sites (think Facebook). This aspect ratio is commonly used for print photographs, mobile screens, and social media platforms, but it's not ideal for most TV or digital formats.

High-resolution JPEG files are used to store large images in a way that prevents too much leaking, or loss, of image details. The format is used by print publications, which have a minimum requirement of 300 dpi (dots per inch).

Each full size raw image is 4672 x 3104 pixels in dimension. So, by multiplying the number of pixels along the width by those of the height (4672 x 3104 = 14,501,888) we get the actual number of pixels in the image. The more pixels an image contains, the bigger the file will be on your computer. Typically images will be supplied as JPEGs, and an A4 (210mm x 297mm or 8¼" x 11¼") image at 72 ppi will create a JPEG of approximately 500kb or half a megabyte.

The file size should be 2550x3300 pixels for best quality. For a high quality 16x20" Print, ensure that your file size is 4800x6000 pixels. For a crisp, clean 8x10" Print, make sure the size of your file is 2400x3000 pixels. Want to print poster-sized? For a sharp 20x24" Print, your file size should be 6000x7200 pixels. For the best 11x14" Prints, ensure that your image's size is 3300x4200 pixels.

Generally, an image with a higher resolution produces a better printed image quality. Same image at 72-ppi and 300-ppi; inset zoom 200%. Unless an image is resampled (see Resampling), the amount of image data remains constant as you change either the print dimensions or resolution.

This particular image is approx. 10" x 8", but the resolution is only 96 ppi—and for printing it must be 300 ppi. To change the resolution to 300 ppi, uncheck the Resample box to lock the Width, Height, and Resolution, then change the Resolution to 300 ppi, like this: Now you can see how big the image is for printing.
